# SCHOOLHOUSE PREPARATORY CHAPTER CAMPAIGN GUIDELINES

Congratulations on choosing to run for an officer position. The campaign guidelines will be explained to the potential officer candidates at an informational meeting. Candidates will be allowed to put up campaign posters, pass out flyers, and they will video tape a one-minute speech to be aired on SPN and on the Schoolhouse Portal. The campaign will last 3 weeks.

#### **VIDEO CAMPAIGN**

- Video recording for speeches from President and Vice President candidates Maximum 1 minutes each
- Video recording for speeches from Secretary and Treasurer candidates Maximum one minute each
- Video recording for speeches from Class Representative Candidates Maximum 30 seconds each
- The candidate will introduce himself/herself during the recording.
- Video Campaign will run on the Portal and school's social media

#### **POSTER CAMPAIGN**

#### **CANDIDATES MUST SUBMIT:**

- a maximum of 3 Standard large Poster Boards must be turned in to Mrs. Harripaul for approval.
- Candidates are responsible for hanging their posters. Areas for poster campaign include all hallways on the first and second floor of the school as well as the student locker area.
- Posters cannot be posted on the outside walls of the building.

#### **CAMPAIGN DO'S AND DON'TS**

- **Do** hand out bookmarks, flyers, stickers, buttons, candy, and cookies.
- Do create a catchy phrase associated with your name to help students remember you.
- **Do** smile and talk to people honestly.
- Do speak to other students and tell them your campaign platform

- **Don't** offer money in exchange for votes
