Let's all Do Our Part**

DO NOT send your child to school if they are experiencing cold or flu like symptoms, has a fever of 100.4 or higher, while anyone in the home is awaiting test results, or if the child is exposed to anyone in the home who is sick.

DO pay attention to the usual childhood illnesses; symptoms are the same as COVID-19 symptoms.

DO wash your hands as frequently as possible or use a hand sanitizer (70% alcohol) when handwashing isn't an option.

DO practice social distancing especially when in closed crowded areas.

DO TRY TO AVOID:

- Crowded indoor environments, or places where others may be "asymptomatic" carriers of the virus.
- Dining at indoor restaurants
- Remaining inside stores or supermarkets for extended periods of time
- Close contact with anyone outside your close family

DO WEAR A MASK whenever you are in a public place where there are people you don't know. It is recommended to wear a mask at home if someone in your household tests positive for COVID-19.

WHAT IS CLOSE CONTACT: According to the CDC, close contact occurs when someone is within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes starting from 2 days before illness onset. For asymptomatic patients, 2 days prior to testing until the time the patient is isolated.

**TRAVEL GUIDELINES FOR SCHOOLHOUSE PREP STUDENTS AND EMPLOYEES
TRAVELING OUTSIDE OF MIAMI DADE COUNTY**

Students or employees traveling outside of Miami-Dade County need to submit a travel form before leaving on your trip. This includes travel within Florida, in the United States and International travel. Student or employee may be required to isolate and self-isolate upon my return to Miami and test using PCR test (not antigen). I understand that COVID-19 testing may be required to return to school or work. I further understand that Virtual learning is available while waiting for test result.

- **Travel by car outside of Miami-Dade County:** This includes social gatherings with persons outside my household, visit to any theme park, etc. Must Self-Isolate for 5 work/school days upon return to Miami and monitor for symptoms. Individual must test for COVID-19 if symptoms develop.
- **Travel by Plane within the US and Florida:** Must isolate for 10 days upon return to Miami and test using PCR test (not antigen). Negative test result must be presented to Schoolhouse Preparatory to return to school or work.
- **International Travel by Plane to a foreign country:** Must isolate for 14 days upon return to Miami and test using PCR test (not antigen). Negative test result must be presented to Schoolhouse Preparatory to return to school or work.
