



SOAR 2024 offers new options for our summer sessions. New this year:

- College and Career SOAR: curriculum developed around college challenges, independent living, and beginning a career path. SOAR will host speakers and workshops along with college counselors to help navigate a good start toward a degree and inclusive employment. SOAR will still include resume reviews and interview practice with human resource professionals to conduct interviews in a more realistic setting. Work on independent living skills, dress, social interactions, social media, and workshops on mental health practices, dating, and learning to network. **Offered June 10-21, 2024, on the FAU campus in Boca Raton**
- Ladies SOAR: This Ladies-only session will focus on topics relevant to young women entering college and the workforce. A review of pre-employment skills, career assessments, self-determination, and speakers on various careers to look ahead. SOAR will assist with social interaction, independent living, dating workshops, and appropriate dress for the workplace. SOAR will continue discussing good mental health practices and nutrition. This session provides good camaraderie and networking skills for young women. **Offered June 24-July 4, 2024, on the FAU campus in Boca Raton**
- Traditional SOAR: Continue with pre-employment skills, self-determination, career assessment, self-care, and transition from school to jobs with a discussion of On-the-Job training (OJT) and employment services. Practice in groups on social interactions, independent living skills, on-campus recreation, and off-campus field trips. This session is designed for students who need to learn how to become independent in work and social situations. **Offered July 8-19, 2024, on the FAU campus in Boca Raton**

· SOAR at Florida International University in Miami: This SOAR session will offer the best of pre-employment skills and career assessment along with options for our college-bound and work-ready young adults. The students will explore career options with speakers from different fields, and review your resume' and job interview skills. A focus on independent living and social interaction combines to have the students become ready to join the inclusive workplace. **Offered June 24-July 4, 2024, on the FIU campus in Miami**
